Safety Rules and Obligations

1. Follow Guide Instructions:

The guide is here to ensure a smooth experience for everyone. Please follow all instructions, including driving speed, route navigation, and stopping points.

2. Stay on the Designated Path:

o For your safety and to protect the environment, remain on the route planned by the guide. They will lead you through the safest paths and areas of interest.

3. Avoid Individual Initiatives and Racing:

• Exploration is exciting, but it's essential to stay within designated areas. Racing or taking unmarked paths can endanger you and others.

4. Care for the Vehicle:

o Treat the buggy with respect and care to ensure its working condition throughout the tour. Damage caused due to negligence will be the participant's responsibility.

5. Helmet and Safety Gear:

• Wearing a helmet is mandatory for all participants. Ensure children passengers are equipped with properly fitted helmets and seatbelts.

6. Maintain a Safe Distance:

 Keep a safe distance between your buggy and others to avoid accidental collisions.

7. Keep the Group's Pace:

o Adjust your speed to remain within reach of the guide and other participants.

8. Respectful Behavior:

 Avoid dangerous or disruptive actions, such as excessive speeding or ignoring instructions, as they can endanger others.

9. **Driver Requirements:**

- o Only individuals with a valid driving license are permitted to drive. Under no circumstances may unlicensed individuals or minors operate the buggy.
- o If a minor is a passenger, their legal guardian or the guide must operate the vehicle.

10. Appropriate Clothing:

 Wear clothing that protects you from thorns, mud, and moisture, particularly in wet conditions. Closed-toe shoes and waterproof gear are highly recommended.

11. Personal Belongings:

 Ensure your belongings are securely stored to prevent loss or damage during the tour. The guide and company are not responsible for items lost due to inattention or improper storage.

12. Guide's Authority to Act on Safety Concerns:

 The guide has the authority to address safety concerns, including issuing warnings or removing participants from the tour if rules are violated. Removal may occur without a refund in serious cases.
